#### Citation managers

- ► Tools to organize, store and retrieve citations
- EndNote is recommended for this course (and for SRs in general) because of its advanced features related to groups, deduplication, etc
- ► HOWEVER, free options like Zotero and Mendeley are useful in other contexts

# Citation manager comparison

EndNote	Zotero	Mendeley
<ul><li>Costs money</li><li>Retrieve citations via direct</li></ul>	<ul><li>Free (can purchase storage)</li><li>Includes browser plugin to</li></ul>	<ul><li>Free (can purchase storage)</li><li>Includes Web Importer in</li></ul>
export or manual import	capture citations in addition to import or manual entry options	addition to import or manual entry options
Embed PDFs via Find Full Text	<ul> <li>Automatically grab PDFs and archive web pages</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Very useful for organizing and annotating PDFs, retrieving citations for PDFs</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Strengths: customization, support, library size</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Strengths: web sync, multiple formats</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Strengths: PDFs, social networking</li> </ul>

- Duplicate papers, not duplicate studies
- John Smith (2020). "Appropriate prescribing of β-lactam antibiotics". Am Fam Physician 1(1), pp. 22-5
- Smith, J. (2020). "Appropriate prescribing of beta-lactam antibiotics". American Family Physician, pp. 22-25.
